BURLCO FARMERS' MARKET HOSTS CHEF SOFIA KARAKASIDOU

Saturday, June 4 Cooking Class at 10 a.m.

Chef Sofia Karakasidou of Kuzina by Sofia in Cherry Hill will offer a cooking class featuring Greek inspired dishes to shoppers at the Burlington County Farmers' Market on Saturday, June 4 at 10 a.m.

Sponsored by the Burlington County Freeholders and located at Hartford and Centeron roads in Moorestown, the farmers' market is open from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. every Saturday, rain or shine (except during declared weather emergencies) now through November 7.

On June 4, live entertainment will be provided by Aaron Hehl, of Moorestown. Hehl is a local pop/rock acoustic singer/songwriter. Sharese Porter from Rutgers Extension is giving a workshop at 11 am on "Try Something New."

Part of the County's Agricultural Center, the farmers' market sells Jersey Fresh fruits and vegetables, baked goods, crafts and more each week. This year, the market is also hosting a series of cooking classes by local chefs. Designed to help shoppers learn new ways to prepare the produce they buy at the market, the demonstration is free to the public. Space is limited and is first-come, first-served.
