CONSTRUCTION TO IMPACT TRAFFIC ON TWO COUNTY ROADS

Local Improvements Scheduled to Begin Tuesday in Shamong, Wrightstown

Motorists can expect delays beginning Tuesday, Sept. 7 as utility construction begins on Jackson Road (County Route 534) in Shamong and at the intersection of Fort Dix Street and Main Street (CR616) in downtown Wrightstown.

Utility Line Services will be installing gas lines along a six-mile stretch of Jackson Road from Atsion Road to the Camden County border in Waterford.

Construction will be performed during the day (7 a.m.-5 p.m.) Mondays through Saturdays and is expected to take five weeks to complete.

Mathis Construction will replace a sewer main for the Wrightstown Municipal Utilities Authority beginning by excavating a 13-foot hole at the intersection of Main Street and Fort Dix Street. This construction will be performed at night (6 p.m.-6 a.m.) and is expected to take three days to complete.

Detours will be posted for both construction projects.
