**TABERNACLE -CHATSWORTH ROAD TO BE CLOSED AFTER LABOR DAY**

**County To Undertake Repairs to Wading River Bridge**

Repairs and maintenance to the bridge over the west branch of the Wading River at Chatsworth Lake will take place shortly after the September 6<sup>th</sup> Labor Day holiday, resulting in the closure of Tabernacle-Chatsworth Road (CR 532) for about five weeks, the Burlington County Highway and Engineering Departments announced today.

The Highway Department is scheduled to mobilize at 9 AM on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, and anticipates completing work on or before Friday, October 15, 2010.

The bridge is located approximately six-tenths of a mile from County Route 563 in Chatsworth and 9.5 miles east of County Route 648 in Tabernacle. It actually spans the river which feeds into Chatsworth Lake in Woodland Township.

Formal notice of the road closure (except for local traffic) is expected to be issued at least two weeks before the start of work. Signs will also be posted on the roadway advising motorists.

A detour route directing traffic to the Chatsworth area via State Highways 70 & 72 will be posted during construction.
