CRISPIN ROAD IN LUMBERTON REOPENED AFTER FIVE MONTHS

Replacement of Bridge Over Rancocas Creek South Branch Began June 18th

Crispin Road in Lumberton between Fostertown Road (County Route 636) and Creek Road (CR640) reopened today to through traffic after more than five months to allow for the replacement of the bridge over a tributary of the Rancocas Creek South Branch, Freeholder Deputy Director Joseph B. Donnelly announced.

“I’m pleased we have completed another essential project – replacing a 70-year-old bridge in poor condition - in the County’s Road and Bridge Plan that improves safety for our motoring public,” Donnelly said. “This was a comprehensive project that was completed on time and on budget, and should be functional for at least another 70 years.”

The former timber bridge was removed and replaced with a pre-stressed concrete beam structure on concrete abutments. Construction included widening 700 feet of roadway approaches to 34 feet to match the width of the new bridge. An 18-foot wide sidewalk was constructed on the bridge to accommodate future plans for municipal paths.

The \$2.1M project was constructed by Marbro, Inc. of West End, Essex County.
