CRISPIN ROAD IN LUMBERTON TO CLOSE FOR FIVE MONTHS

Bridge Replacement Scheduled to Begin Monday, June 18th

Crispin Road in Lumberton between Fostertown Road (County Route 636) and Creek Road (CR640) will be closed to through traffic for approximately five months beginning Monday, June 18 to allow for the replacement of the bridge over a tributary of the Rancocas Creek South Branch.

The road will remain open to local traffic on both sides to the bridge. A detour has been established to Creek Road (CR640) to Main Street (CR541) to Fostertown Road (CR636).

The current timber bridge will be removed and replaced with a pre-stressed concrete beam structure on concrete abutments. Construction will include widening 700 feet of roadway approaches to 34 feet to match the width of the new bridge. An 18-foot wide sidewalk will be constructed on the bridge to accommodate future plans for municipal paths.

The \$2.1M project will be constructed by Marbro, Inc. of West End, Essex County.
