PORTION OF FORT DIX STREET IN WRIGHTSTOWN TO BE RESURFACED

0.2-Mile Construction Project Expected to Begin Monday

Resurfacing of a 0.2-mile portion of Fort Dix Street (County Route 545) from Main Street to 1,000 feet south of Main Street in Wrightstown is scheduled to begin Monday, October 17.

The milling and repaving is expected to take about two weeks to complete, and traffic will be maintained during construction. Motorists may experience delays during construction and are advised to seek alternative routes.

Neshaminy Constructors, Inc./American Asphalt Co., Inc. – A Joint Venture of West Collingswood is the contractor. The project is part of the County's \$6.8M 2010 State Funded Overlay Program that is scheduled to resurface a total 29.7 miles of County roads in 17 municipalities.
