MARNE HIGHWAY SCHEDULED TO BE RESURFACED
Construction Set To Begin Monday in Mt. Laurel, Hainesport

Construction on Marne Highway (County Route 537) from 1,300 feet east of Hartford Road (CR686) in Mount Laurel to the Mount Holly Bypass (CR541) in Hainesport is scheduled to begin this Monday, July 19th, Freeholder Deputy Director Joseph B. Donnelly announced today.

The project involves milling, overlay and reconstruction of handicap ramps along the 4.4-mile portion of Marne Highway. Construction is expected to take about three weeks to complete.

Traffic will be maintained but motorists may experience delays during this period. Motorists are advised to seek alternative routes during work.

Arawak Paving Company Inc. of Hammonton was awarded the contract as lowest responsible bidder. The project is being funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), referred to as federal stimulus funding.

A total 12.1 miles of County roads in six municipalities are scheduled to be resurfaced with a total of \$2.29 million in stimulus funds awarded in January of 2010.
