4-H activities take place through project clubs located throughout the county. Volunteer adults serve as 4-H leaders, and every club has at least two adult leaders.

To find out how to serve as a volunteer or how to start a club, please call the 4-H office at (609) 265-5052 on weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., or leave a message in the evening and on weekends.
