The Chairperson of the County Committee authorizes the use of the County Committee's slogan on the ballot. If the Chairperson does not authorize the use of their slogan for one or more candidates, the Clerk's Office will use the second-choice slogan for the ballot.

Petitions may not be circulated without the candidate(s)'s name, address, and office sought written on the petition.

- Print the petition on one-sided pages.
- Carefully review the petition and fill in all the blank spaces.
- Please write clearly. Do not type, pre-fill, or e-sign signatures.
- Candidates must be registered voters, be at least 18 years old, and have lived in the voting district for at least one year before the General Election (Chapter 94 Laws of 1980).
- Male and female County Committee candidates in the same voting district may file a joint petition.
- Every candidate must sign a Certificate of Acceptance and an Oath of Allegiance, both of which must be notarized.
- P.L. 2018, Chapter 66, requires each candidate to submit a personal or campaign email address and advises against using official government email addresses.
- The person whose presence is witnessed during the signing of the petition (the circulator) MUST be one of the petition signers and must make an affidavit as an Affiant before a notary or other officer authorized by law to take the affidavit.
- Under P.L. 2014, Chapter 83, the individual circulating the petition must be a registered voter in this state and must belong to the same political party as the one named in the petition.
- Petitioners must sign their names in their own handwriting, ensure their signatures match those on their voter registration, and provide their correct address in front of the person witnessing the signatures.
- Candidates can circulate and sign their petitions. Candidate signatures are included in the total needed.
- The circulator (the person gathering signatures) MUST sign the petition and indicate where they signed.
- Only legally qualified voters in New Jersey who live in the same voting district and belong to the same political party as the candidate are allowed to sign the petition.
- Each voter is allowed to sign for the same candidate only once and must not sign for more candidates than there are available seats.
- The Burlington County Clerk's Office will hold a public ballot draw at 3 PM on the 61st day before the Primary Election, at the County Clerk's Office located at 50 Rancocas Road, 3rd Floor, in Mount Holly.
- The primary ballot will be organized by office position rather than by column or row, with each office on the ballot randomly ordered based on the ballot draw. If there is only one male and/or female County Committee candidate for a voting district, the position does not need to be drawn.
- County Committee Signature Requirements – At least 10 valid signatures or 5% of the total votes cast by the party's voters in the last primary election for party candidates for the General Assembly. If your municipality has recently undergone redistricting, calculating the 5% signature requirement might be difficult due to new voting district boundaries. Candidates in redistricted areas are advised to gather more than 10 signatures to ensure they qualify for the ballot.

Recommendations for Petitioners

- Begin the process and submit your petition early.
- Check with your municipal clerk to verify the number of signatures required.
- Obtain 10% to 20% more signatures than the minimum required.
- Make sure everything is signed and notarized correctly, and that all requested information is included. If you want a nickname or alternate name to appear on the ballot instead of your legal name, include a letter requesting this with your petition.
