Age Requirement – 3 years or older to test. An adult must accompany minors under the age of 16.

Tests Available:

- Pharmacy Clinic: PCR and Rapid-result tests
- At-home testing (available over the counter or online): PCR, Rapid Antigen, and Antibody tests

Which COVID-19 test is right for you?

- PCR - detects active infections and confirmed by a lab in a few days.
- Rapid Antigen Test - Detect active infections with 24 hours.
- Antibody Test - detects antibodies to see if you have been exposed to COVID-19 (past infection). Antibody tests will not tell you if you have immunity.

NOTE: Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should be tested using the PCR and/or rapid antigen test. If exposed to a known COVID-19 positive person, it is recommended to get tested 5-7 day after exposure.

COVID-19 Symptoms: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea
