## Crisis Services:

**Screening & Crisis Intervention Program (SCIP)** provides mobile outreaches to consumers experiencing psychiatric crisis. Open 24 hours a day, SCIP offers emergency psychiatric services and aims to maximize use of the least restrictive alternative for treatment of psychiatric illness. **(609) 835-6180**

### ***Legacy Treatment Services***

**PerformCare** helps connect children up to age 21 to the behavioral health, substance use, or developmental disability services he or she needs to be well and thrive. These may include services available through regular health insurance plans, community resources, or public services. **1-877-652-7624**

**Early Intervention Support Services (EISS)** offers an alternative for adults age 18 and older who are experiencing emotional distress, but not in need of hospitalization. Provides screening and counseling services in a safe, home-like setting. No appointment or referral needed. **(609) 386-7331** *Catholic Charities Open 7 days a week (8am-8pm)*

**Intensive Family Support Services (IFSS)** Provides consultation, psycho-educational and family support groups, respite care, advocacy and service to linkage to families with members experiencing a serious mental illness. **(609) 267-9339 Ext. 2824**

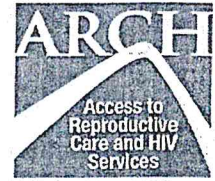

Goals include reducing the frequency and length of hospitalization, increasing connections to community services, and improving quality of life. ***Oaks Integrated Care:*** (609) 265-0245

**Justice Involved Services (JIS):** Provides outreach services to support & integrate clients into the community after discharge from incarceration. ***Oaks Integrated Care:*** (609) 265-0245

**RITE Center (Realizing Independence Through Empowerment):** The RITE Center focuses on supporting those with mental health and/or addiction issues to lead a life of wellness and recovery. ***Oaks Integrated Care:*** (609) 518-7293
