

| Safety Tips To Live By | |
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| <p>Stay Alert</p> <p>Dedicate full attention to the roadway.</p> | <p>Change Lanes Safely</p> <p>Change lanes only when pavement markings indicate and only when traffic conditions permit.</p> |
| <p>Minimize Distractions</p> <p>Avoid changing radio stations, using mobile phones, eating, and other distractions that can remove driver concentration from the road.</p> | <p>Follow Flagger Instructions</p> <p>A flagger has the same authority as a regulatory sign so you can be fined for disobeying directions.</p> |
| <p>Pay Close Attention</p> <p>Listen to the signs. Watch brake lights on vehicles ahead. Watch traffic around you and be prepared to react.</p> | <p>Expect the Unexpected</p> <p>Workers, work vehicles, or equipment may enter your lane without warning. Other vehicles may slow, stop, or change lanes unexpectedly.</p> |
| <p>Don't Tailgate</p> <p>Keep at least two car lengths between you and the car ahead.</p> | <p>Expect Delays</p> <p>Plan for them and leave early to reach your destination on time. Take an alternate route if possible.</p> |
| <p>Obey Posted Speed Limits</p> <p>Speeding is a major cause of crashes. Fines are doubled for moving traffic violations in work zones.</p> | <p>Be Patient and Stay Calm</p> <p>Remember: The goal of the work zone crew is to improve the road and your future drive.</p> |
